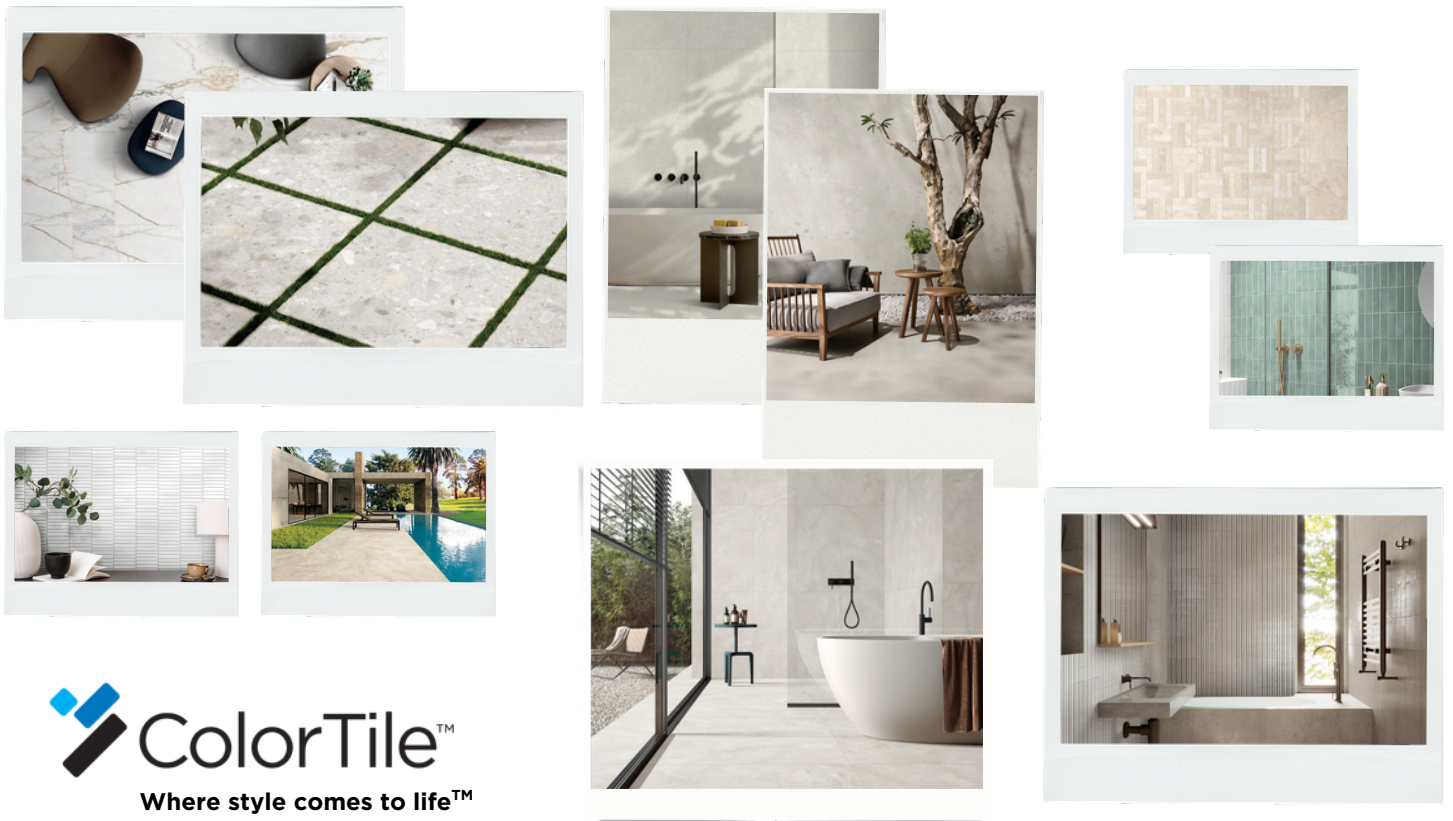

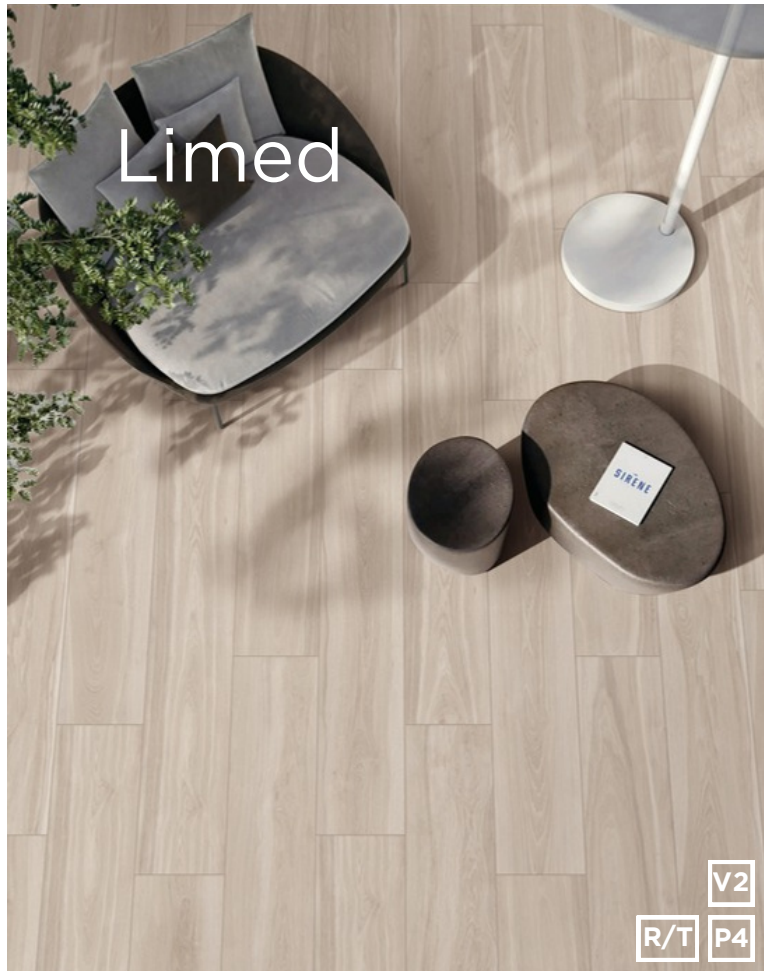

# Technical Information

## V-Rating

The V Rating indicates the amount of variation you can expect between individual tiles within the same collection. This helps create either a more uniform appearance or a more natural, organic look.

- **V1 - Uniform Appearance** - Tiles have very little variation from piece to piece. This creates a clean, consistent look and is often preferred in contemporary or minimalist designs.
- **V2 - Slight Variation** - Tiles feature minor differences in shade and pattern while maintaining an overall consistent appearance.
- **V3 - Moderate Variation** - Noticeable differences in colour, pattern and texture occur between tiles, creating a more natural and visually interesting installation.
- **V4 - Substantial Variation** - Each tile can vary significantly in colour, pattern and movement. When installed, the result closely resembles natural stone, timber or handmade materials, delivering a unique and highly individual look.

If choosing a V3 to V4, it is important that you refer to the catalogue to understand what you should expect and/or consider asking for more samples.



Shade variation is based on production run. Some tiles look the same when they belong to the same production run, but different when they have been produced in different runs. The changes relate to slight temperature or colouring changes. **RECOMMENDATIONS** - Once delivered, check the tiles in all cartons to see if they are the same colour. Also check the code numbers of the boxes to see if they are from the same batch.

## P-Rating

The P Rating measures a tile's slip resistance underfoot and is determined by testing the tile in wet conditions. The higher the rating, the greater the slip resistance.

- **P0 - Not classified**
- **P1 - Very low slip resistance**
- **P2 - Dry internal areas**
- **P3 - General residential interiors**
- **P4 - Areas exposed to occasional moisture**
- **P5 - High-slip-risk environments**

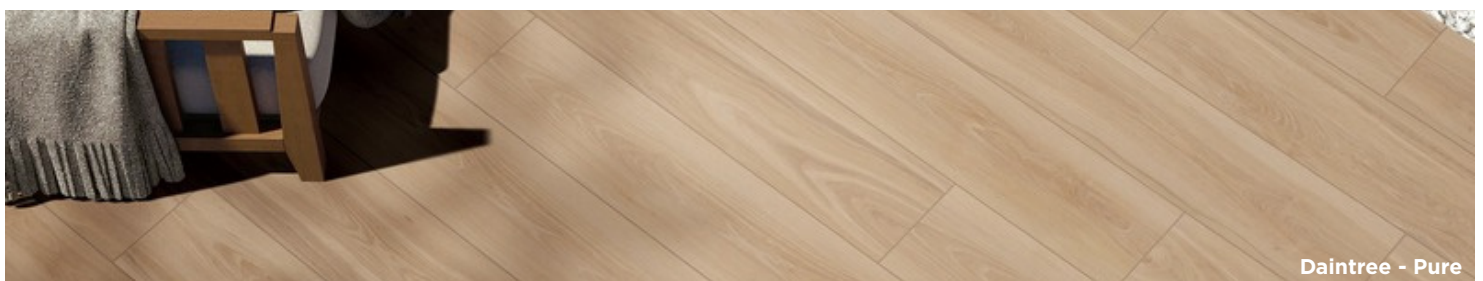
### P Rating Notice

Lappato, Honed, Polished and Satin finishes are not P-tested and therefore do not have a P Rating. As a result, no P Rating is shown for these products in this catalogue. Where slip resistance is a project requirement, please contact your local ColorTile store for further guidance.

## Rectified Tile (R/T)

**R/T** denotes a rectified tile, meaning the edges have been precisely machined after firing to create consistent sizing and sharp, square edges. This allows for tighter grout joints and a cleaner, more refined finish.

Products that do not display R/T feature a **non-rectified edge detail** and will require a larger grout joint as the Australian Standards **AS 3958**.
